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UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS

S. 524 (ORDER NO. 369)

1.—*Ordered*, That upon the conclusion of Morning Business on Wednesday, March 9, 2016, the Senate resume consideration of S. 524, a bill to authorize the Attorney General to award grants to address the national epidemics of prescription opioid abuse and heroin use; provided, that the time until 12:00 noon be equally divided between the two managers or their designees; provided further, that, notwithstanding the provisions of Rule XXII, all post-cloture time on Amdt. No. 3378, as amended, offered by the Senator from Iowa (Mr. Grassley), expire at 12:00 noon; further, that all time during Morning Business, recess, and adjournment of the Senate count post-cloture on Amdt. No. 3378, as amended; further, that with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on S. 524, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived; further, that the filing deadline for first degree amendments to Amdt. No. 3378, as amended, and S. 524 be at 3:30 p.m. on Monday, March 7, 2016. (*Mar. 3, 7, 8, 2016.*)

S. 2012 (ORDER NO. 218)

2.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motions to invoke cloture on Amdt. No. 2953, offered by the Senator from Alaska (Ms. Murkowski), and S. 2012, a bill to provide for the modernization of the energy policy of the United States, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived; provided, that the filing deadline for all first degree amendments to Amdt. No. 2953 and S. 2012 be at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 3, 2016. (*Feb. 2, 2016.*)

H.R. 2685 (ORDER NO. 118)

3.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the cloture motion on the motion to proceed to H.R. 2685, an act making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived. (*Nov. 3, 2015.*)

S. 1881 (ORDER NO. 169)

4.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 1881, a bill to prohibit Federal funding of Planned Parenthood Federation of America, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived. (*Aug. 3, 2015.*)

S. 1357 (ORDER NO. 86)

5.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 1357, a bill to extend authority relating to roving surveillance, access to business records, and individual terrorists as agents of foreign powers under the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 until July 31, 2015, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived. (*May 23, 2015.*)

S. 534 (ORDER NO. 22)

6.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 534, a bill to prohibit funds from being used to carry out certain Executive actions related to immigration, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*Feb. 27, 2015.*)
