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UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS

H.R. 2028 (ORDER NO. 96)

1.—*Ordered*, That upon the conclusion of Morning Business on Thursday, May 12, 2016, the Senate resume consideration of H.R. 2028, an Act making appropriations for energy and water development and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, and for other purposes; provided, that all time during the adjournment and Morning Business count post-cloture on Amdt. No. 3801, offered by the Senator from Tennessee (Mr. Alexander), as amended.

Ordered further, That Amdt. No. 3801, as amended, be considered a committee-reported substitute; provided, that with respect to the motions to invoke cloture on Amdt. No. 3801, as amended, and H.R. 2028, the mandatory quorums required under Rule XXII be waived.

Ordered further, That with respect to Amdt. No. 3801, as amended, for the purposes of Rule XXII, the filing deadline for all first degree amendments be 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 10, and the second degree filing deadline occur as under Rule XXII; provided, that with respect to H.R. 2028, the filing deadline for all first degree amendments be 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 26, and the filing deadline for all second degree amendments occur as under Rule XXII. (*Apr. 20, 25, 26, May 9, 11, 2016.*)

HOUSE MESSAGE TO ACCOMPANY S. 764

2.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to concur in the House amendment to S. 764, a bill to reauthorize and amend the National Sea Grant College Program Act, and for other purposes, with Amdt. No. 3450, offered by the Senator from Kentucky (Mr. McConnell), the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*Mar. 14, 2016.*)

H.R. 2685 (ORDER NO. 118)

3.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the cloture motion on the motion to proceed to H.R. 2685, an act making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived. (*Nov. 3, 2015.*)

S. 1881 (ORDER NO. 169)

4.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 1881, a bill to prohibit Federal funding of Planned Parenthood Federation of America, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived. (*Aug. 3, 2015.*)

S. 1357 (ORDER NO. 86)

5.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 1357, a bill to extend authority relating to roving surveillance, access to business records, and individual terrorists as agents of foreign powers under the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 until July 31, 2015, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum under Rule XXII be waived. (*May 23, 2015.*)

S. 534 (ORDER NO. 22)

6.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to S. 534, a bill to prohibit funds from being used to carry out certain Executive actions related to immigration, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum required under Rule XXII be waived. (*Feb. 27, 2015.*)
