1.—*Ordered*, That on Monday, March 27, 2023, following the conclusion of Morning Business, the Senate resume consideration of S. 316, a bill to repeal the authorizations for use of military force against Iraq; provided, that at a time to be determined by the Majority Leader following consultation with the Republican Leader, the Senate vote in relation to the following amendments, if offered, with 60 affirmative votes required for adoption, and without intervening action or debate:
