- H.R. 4 An act to rescind certain budget authority proposed to be rescinded in special messages transmitted to the Congress by the President on June 3, 2025, in accordance with section 1012(a) of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974. Approved July 24, 2025. Public Law 119–28.
- H.R. 42 An act to amend the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act to exclude certain payments to aged, blind, or disabled Alaska Natives or descendants of Alaska Natives from being used to determine eligibility for certain programs, and for other purposes. Approved July 7, 2025. Public Law 119–22.

- H.R. 452 An act to award 3 Congressional Gold Medals to the members of the 1980 U.S. Olympic Men’s Ice Hockey Team, in recognition of their extraordinary achievement at the 1980 Winter Olympics where, being comprised of amateur collegiate players, they defeated the dominant Soviet hockey team in the historic “Miracle on Ice”, revitalizing American morale at the height of the Cold War, inspiring generations and transforming the sport of hockey in the United States. - H.R. 517 An act to amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to modify the rules for postponing certain deadlines by reason of disaster. Approved July 24, 2025. Public Law 119–29.
- H.R. 618 An act to amend the Apex Project, Nevada Land Transfer and Authorization Act of 1989 to include the City of North Las Vegas and the Apex Industrial Park Owners Association, and for other purposes. Approved July 15, 2025. Public Law 119–24.
- H.R. 695 An act to amend title 38, United States Code, to increase the rate of the special pension payable to Medal of Honor recipients, and for other purposes. Approved Dec. 1, 2025. Public Law 119–43.
