**UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS**

## H.J. RES. 42

1.—*Ordered*, That on Wednesday, April 30, 2025, following the conclusion of Morning Business, the Senate resume consideration of H.J. Res. 42, a joint resolution providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the rule submitted by the Department of Energy relating to “Energy Conservation Program for Appliance Standards: Certification Requirements, Labeling Requirements, and Enforcement Provisions for Certain Consumer Products and Commercial Equipment”; provided, that at 11:30 a.m., all debate time on the joint resolution be expired, the joint resolution be read a third time, and the Senate vote on passage of the joint resolution. (*April 29, 2025.*)

## S.J. RES. 49

2.—*Ordered*, That notwithstanding Rule XXII, at a time to be determined by the Majority Leader, in consultation with the Democratic Leader, no earlier than Wednesday, April 30, 2025, S.J. Res. 49, a joint resolution terminating the national emergency declared to impose global tariffs, be discharged from the Committee on Finance and the Senate proceed to its consideration; provided, that there be 6 hours for debate only with the time equally divided between the Leaders or their designees; provided further, that following the use or yielding back of that time, the joint resolution be read a third time and the Senate vote on passage of the joint resolution. (*April 28, 2025.*)
