UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENTS**H.R. 5371 (ORDER NO. 168)**

1.—*Ordered*, That on Monday, November 10, 2025, upon the conclusion of Morning Business, the Senate resume consideration of the motion to proceed to H.R. 5371, an Act making continuing appropriations and extensions for fiscal year 2026, post-cloture; provided, that all time during recess, adjournment, Morning Business, and Leader remarks count post-cloture. (*Nov. 9, 2025.*)

H.R. 4016 (ORDER NO. 136)

2.—*Ordered*, That with respect to the entered motion to reconsider the motion to invoke cloture on the motion to proceed to H.R. 4016, an Act making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, and for other purposes, the mandatory quorum call under Rule XXII be waived.
