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ALEXIS M. HERMAN, of Mobile, AL, Secretary of Labor; graduated from Xavier University, New Orleans, LA in 1969; began her career as a social worker for Catholic Charities, developing training opportunities for unemployed youth, unskilled workers and new entrants to the Mobile labor force at Ingall's Shipbuilding, Inc., in Pascagoula, MS; in the 1980s, founded A.M. Herman and Associates, a human resources consulting firm with corporate and government clients; director of the Women's Bureau, U.S. Department of Labor, during the Carter administration; chief executive officer of the 1992 Democratic National Convention Committee; deputy director of the Presidential Transition Office, 1992; assistant to President Clinton and director of the White House Public Liaison Office; confirmed as the twenty-third Secretary of Labor by the U.S. Senate, May 2, 1997.
