WILLIAM JEFFERSON CLINTON, Democrat, of Arkansas; born in Hope, AR, August 19, 1946; attended public schools in Hope and Hot Springs, AR; B.S., Georgetown University, 1968; Rhodes Scholar, Oxford University, England, 1968–70; J.D., Yale Law School, 1973; professor, University of Arkansas, 1973–76; attorney general, State of Arkansas, 1977–79; counsel, Wright, Lindsey, and Jennings, Little Rock, 1981–83; elected Governor of Arkansas, 1979–81 and 1983–92; chair: National Governor's Association; the Education Commission of the States; the Lower Mississippi Delta Development Commission; the Southern Growth Policies Board; Democratic Governor's Association; Democratic Leadership Council; married to Hillary Rodham Clinton; one daughter, Chelsea; elected the 42nd President of the United States, November 3, 1992; inaugurated January 20, 1993; reelected November 1996.
