CRAIG THOMAS, Republican, of Casper, WY; born in Cody, WY, February 17, 1933; education: graduated from Cody High School; B.S., University of Wyoming, 1955; military service: served in the U.S. Marine Corps, captain, 1955–59; small businessman; vice president, Wyoming Farm Bureau, 1959–66; American Farm Bureau, 1966–75; general manager, Wyoming Rural Electric Association, 1975–89; member: Wyoming House of Representatives, 1984–89; married: Susan Thomas; children: Peter, Paul, Lexi and Patrick; elected to the U.S. House of Representatives, by special election, on April 25, 1989, to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Dick Cheney; reelected to each succeeding Congress; committees: Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry; Energy and Natural Resources; Finance; Indian Affairs; Select Committee on Ethics; elected to the U.S. Senate in November, 1994; reelected to each succeeding Senate term.
