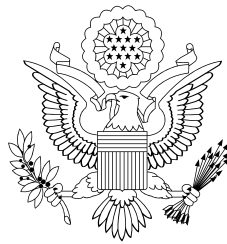

The old 7th District will no longer exist on December 31, 2018.

¹⁰ This seat is in interim vacant status. The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania redrew the district in February 2018. Boundaries of the old 15th District will be compressed, becoming the 7th District. The old 5th District will have its boundaries adjusted to become the 15th district for the 2018 election.

The *Congressional Directory* is one of the oldest working handbooks within the United States Government. While there were unofficial directories for Congress in one form or another beginning with the 1st Congress in 1789, the *Congressional Directory* published in 1847 for the 30th Congress is considered by scholars and historians to be the first official edition because it was the first to be ordered and paid for by Congress. With the addition of biographical sketches of legislators in 1867, the *Congressional Directory* attained its modern format.

The *Congressional Directory* is published by the United States Congress in partnership with the Government Publishing Office, at the direction of the Joint Committee on Printing under the authority of Title 44, Section 721 of the U.S. Code.
