OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET
CUMULATIVE REPORT ON RESCISSIONS AND DEFERRALS

April 1, 1998

This report is submitted in fulfillment of the requirement of Section 1014(e) of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-344). Section 1014(e) requires a monthly report listing all budget authority for the current fiscal year for which, as of the first day of the month, a special message had been transmitted to Congress.

This report gives the status, as of April 1, 1998, of 24 rescission proposals and eight deferrals contained in two special messages for FY 1998. These messages were transmitted to Congress on February 3 and February 20, 1998.

Rescissions (Attachments A and C)

As of April 1, 1998, 24 rescission proposals totaling \$20 million had been transmitted to the Congress. Attachment C shows the status of the FY 1998 rescission proposals.

Deferrals (Attachments B and D)

As of April 1, 1998, \$3,451 million in budget authority was being deferred from obligation. Attachment D shows the status of each deferral reported during FY 1998.
