SIR: In accordance with provisions of P.L. 105-277, the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999, I hereby request the following:

DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE

Operation and Maintenance, Operation and maintenance, Defense-wide: \$569,600,000.

These funds will support critical national security activities.

I hereby designate the above request as an emergency requirement pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985, as amended.

The details of this action are set forth in the enclosed letter from the Director of the Office of Management and Budget. I concur with his comments and observations.

Submitted for your consideration is a request to make available \$569.6 million in previously appropriated emergency funds for the Department of Defense.

P.L. 105-277, the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999, provided \$1.5 billion in emergency funding for defense-wide operation and maintenance activities contingent upon the President submitting a budget request to the Congress and designating the entire amount requested as an emergency requirement. This amount, provided in Division B, Title I, Chapter I of the Act, includes funding for national security activities. On December 21, 1998, you made available \$275 million for such activities. At this time, an additional \$569.6 million is needed to support a variety of national security programs. The purpose for which the \$569.6 million will be used is provided under separate classification.

I recommend that you designate the \$569.6 million as an emergency requirement in accordance with section 251(b)(2)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985, as amended. No further congressional action will be required.

I have carefully reviewed this proposal and am satisfied that it is necessary at this time. Therefore, I recommend that you make the requested funds available by signing the enclosed letter to the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
