SUBJECT: Designation of Funding as an Emergency Requirement

The Congress designated as an emergency requirement certain funding in divisions A and B of the American Relief Act (H.R. 10545; the "Act"). Section 21304 of division B of the Act provides that the availability of funding that is designated by the Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (BBEDCA) is contingent upon the President subsequently so designating all such amounts and transmitting such designations to the Congress. These requirements are a result of the enactment of the Fiscal Responsibility Act of 2023, which reinstated discretionary spending caps.

The Act provides a net total of \$117 billion in fiscal year (FY) 2025 emergency funding to respond to and recover from: Hurricanes Beryl, Ian, Idalia, Helene, Hilary, Laura, Milton, and Nicole; wildfires including Maui wildfires and for Hermit's Peak/Calf Canyon Fire Assistance Act funding; Typhoon Mawar; and other severe storms, tornadoes, drought, tropical storms, and floods occurring predominantly in calendar years 2023 and 2024. Emergency funding is also provided for: the Departments of Defense, Energy, Justice, and the Treasury to conduct risk reduction and modification of National Security Systems; the *Virginia*-Class Submarine program; the protection of the residences of the Supreme Court Justices; the consequences of the Francis Scott Key Bridge collapse; and assistance to States for an emerging eastern spruce budworm outbreak approaching the northeastern U.S. border.

I recommend that you designate as emergency requirements all funding so designated by the Congress in the Act pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(A) of BBEDCA, as outlined in the enclosed list of accounts. Upon transmittal of these designations to the Congress, these funds will be immediately available for obligation and expenditure. No further congressional action will be required.

The designation of these funds as emergency requirements allows for adjustments to the discretionary spending limits in FY 2025, as specified in section 251(b)(2)(A) of BBEDCA. These adjustments will be reflected when the Office of Management and Budget submits its final sequestration report for FY 2025 in accordance with section 254(f) of BBEDCA.

I have reviewed this proposed action and am satisfied it is necessary at this time. Therefore, I recommend that you make the requested funds available by signing the enclosed message to the Congress.
