AN ACT To strike the sunset on certain provisions relating to the authorized protest of a task or delivery order under section 4106 of title 41, United States Code.

United States of America in Congress assembled,*

SECTION 1. [41 U.S.C. 101 note] SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the “GAO Civilian Task and Delivery Order Protest Authority Act of 2016”.

SEC. 2. ORDERS.

Section 4106(f) of title 41, United States Code, is amended by striking paragraph (3).
