Reports Filed: Reports were filed today as follows:

H.R. 7872, to amend the Colorado River Basin Salinity Control Act to modify certain requirements applicable to salinity control units, and for other purposes (H. Rept. 118–709);

H.R. 6395, to amend the Energy Act of 2020 to require the Secretary of the Interior to include the Secretary of Health and Human Services in consultations regarding designations of critical minerals, elements, substances, and materials (H. Rept. 118–710);

H.R. 3675, to amend the Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation Act to extend certain contract prepayment authority, with an amendment (H. Rept. 118–711);

H.R. 1314, to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to enter into partnerships to develop housing, and for other purposes (H. Rept. 118–712);

H.R. 4141, to provide that certain communications projects are not subject to requirements to prepare certain environmental or historical preservation reviews, and for other purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 118–713, Part 1);

H.R. 3499, to amend title 5, United States Code, to provide direct hire authority to appoint individuals to Federal wildland firefighting and firefighting support positions in the Forest Service or the De-

partment of the Interior, and for other purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 118–714, Part 1); and

H.R. 1786, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to submit to Congress a report on the Warrior Training Advancement Course, to direct the Secretary of the Interior to administer a pilot program to employ veterans in positions that relate to conservation and resource management activities of the Department of the Interior, and for other purposes (H. Rept. 118–715, Part 1). **Pages H5887–88**
