Condemning the Rise in Attacks on Jewish Individuals: Committee on the Judiciary was discharged from further consideration of S. Res. 288, condemning the rise in ideologically motivated attacks on Jewish individuals in the United States, including the recent violent assault in Boulder, Colorado, and reaffirming the commitment of the Senate to combating antisemitism and politically motivated violence, and the resolution was then agreed to.

Van Hook, of Louisiana, to be United States District Judge for the Western District of Louisiana, and Senate execute the order of December 18, 2025, in relation to the nomination at 1:45 p.m.

Committee on Rules: Full Committee concluded a hearing on H.R. 4593, the “SHOWER Act”; H.R. 5184, the “Affordable HOMES Act”; and H.R. 6938, the “Commerce, Justice, Science; Energy and Water Development; and Interior and Environment Appropriations Act, 2026”. The Committee granted, by a record vote of 8–3, a rule providing for consideration of H.R. 4593, the “SHOWER Act”, H.R. 5184, the “Affordable HOMES Act”, and H.R. 6938, the “Commerce, Justice, Science; Energy and Water Development; and Interior and Environment Appropriations Act, 2026”. The rule provides for consideration of H.R. 4593, the “SHOWER Act”, under a closed rule. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. The rule provides that the bill shall be considered as read. The rule waives all points of order against provisions in the bill. The rule provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce or their respective designees. The rule provides one motion to recommit. The rule further provides for consideration of H.R. 5184, the “Affordable HOMES Act”, under a closed rule. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. The rule provides that the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted and the bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. The rule waives all points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended. The rule provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce or their respective designees. The rule provides one motion to recommit. The rule further provides for consideration of H.R. 6938, the “Commerce, Justice, Science; Energy and Water Development; and Interior and Environment Appropriations Act, 2026”, under a closed

rule. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. The rule provides that the bill shall be considered as read. The rule waives all points of order against provisions in the bill. The rule provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations or their respective designees. The rule provides that the Chair shall put the question on retaining Division A and retaining Divisions B and C of the bill in the order specified by the Chair; provides that the yeas and nays shall be considered as ordered on each of the questions; and provides that the Chair shall then put the question on engrossment and third reading of the text comprising those portions of the bill retained. The rule provides one motion to recommit. The rule directs the Clerk, in the engrossment of H.R. 6938, to make technical and conforming changes in the event a portion of the bill is not retained. Finally, the rule provides that the chair of the Committee on Appropriations may insert in the Congressional Record not later than January 9th, 2026, such material as he may deem explanatory of H.R. 6938.
