## R E P O R T

[To accompany H. Res. 602]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House  
Resolution 602, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House  
with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

### SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration of House Joint Resolu-  
tion 124, making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal  
year 2003, and for other purposes, under a closed rule. The rule  
provides one hour of debate in the House equally divided and con-  
trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-  
mittee on Appropriations.

The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the  
joint resolution. The rule provides one motion to recommit House  
Joint Resolution 124.

The rule further provides for consideration of H.R. 5708, to re-  
duce preexisting PAYGO balances, and for other purposes, under a  
closed rule providing one hour of debate in the House equally di-  
vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority mem-  
ber of the Committee on the Budget.

The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the  
joint resolution. Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit  
H.R. 5708.
