## R E P O R T

[To accompany H. Res. 572]

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution 572, by a record vote of 9 to 4, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

### SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for the consideration of H. Res. 571, expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the deployment of United States forces in Iraq be terminated immediately, under a closed rule. The rule provides one hour of debate in the House equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on International Relations. The rule provides one motion to recommit which may not contain instructions.

Finally, the rule provides that upon adoption of the resolution, House Concurrent Resolution 308 is hereby adopted.
