SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution relates to the consideration of H.R. 5724, to implement the United States-Colombia Trade Promotion Agreement. The resolution provides that section 151(e)(1) and section 151(f)(1) of the Trade Act of 1974 shall not apply in the case of H.R. 5724.
