Joint Statement by the United States, France, and the United Kingdom on Nuclear Threat Reduction

February 23, 2024

The United States, France, and the United Kingdom ("P3") held nuclear threat reduction consultations among senior Elysée, White House, and Cabinet Office officials. These exchanges are part of longstanding and ongoing trilateral cooperation to prevent the proliferation of nuclear materials to non-state actors and to advance collaborative capabilities to counter the threat of weapons of mass destruction terrorism worldwide.

NOTE: The Office of the Press Secretary released this joint statement following a United States, France, and United Kingdom trilateral meeting in which the U.S. delegation was led by Homeland Security Adviser Elizabeth D. Sherwood-Randall. An original was not available for verification of the content of this joint statement.
