

**Remarks During a Telerally for Florida Republican Congressional Candidate
Jimmy Patronis
March 27, 2025**

Well, Jimmy, thank you very much, and I have to start by saying hello to Helen. And Helen is a phenomenal woman who created a very beautiful young man named Jimmy.

And I hope you're going to get out and vote. The First Congressional District is special. I've—I won it by a lot, and Jimmy is going to win it by a lot.

And remember, you're 5 days away from this all-important special election taking place in your district on Tuesday, April 1. So April Fool's Day, so it's going to be the fool for the Democrat candidate, who happens to be terrible. And I'm really just asking you to get out and vote.

And you're true patriots, everybody on this line, and it's Jimmy Patronis. There's nobody like him. He's been a great success in Florida for a long time.

Early voting is underway and continues through Saturday, so you can go out early. Right now, you can go out and vote, and it's going to be something very special, very—the whole country is actually watching this one. It's a very big one.

And I have to say, Jimmy has a big lead in the polls, but we've got to make it too big to rig. You know? You know the expression. That's one—the one I used, and we had a tremendous election. We ended racist DEI programs and banned men from playing in women's sports, which is sounding simple, but it's not simple at all. It's something they want, and it's an ideology.
