**SUMMARY:** An environmental assessment on the Council's proposed regulatory revisions of its rule, published in this issue of the **Federal Register**, was

prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), 42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq., and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's NEPA regulations, 36 CFR part 805. The proposed rule implements Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. The environmental assessment made a preliminary determination that promulgation of the revised rule will not have a significant impact on the quality of the human environment and that preparation of an environmental impact statement will not be necessary.
