#### Television Broadcasting Services; Decatur, Plano, TX

**AGENCY:** Federal Communications Commission.

**ACTION:** Proposed rule.

**SUMMARY:** The Commission requests comments on a petition for rule making filed by Word of God Fellowship, Inc. ("petitioner"), requesting the reallocation of Television Channel 29 from Decatur to Plano, Texas as the community's first local transmission service. Petitioner is asked to provide additional information in support of the requested reallocation, specifically, an analysis of the Urbanized Areas involved using the Commission's relevant cases, and a showing that the companion digital channel at Decatur should also be reallocated to Plano. Channel 29 can be reallocated from Decatur to Plano in compliance with the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements at the petitioner's requested site, at coordinates 32-52-16 NL and 96-55-22 WL31-06-18 North Latitude and 91-54-26 West Longitude.
