

or virtual energy in the Day-ahead and Real-time Markets of the various Independent System Operators and Regional Transmission Organizations.” *Id.*

The Applicant states that it “has no electric power supply system on which the proposed exports could have a reliability, fuel use system, or stability impact” and has “no obligation to serve native load usually associated with a franchised service area.” App. at 3–4. Danske Commodities represents that it will purchase “power to be exported from a variety of sources, including but not limited to, power marketers, independent power producers, or U.S. electric utilities and federal power marketing entities[.]” *Id.* at 4. The Applicant thus asserts that its proposed exports “will not impair the sufficiency of the electric power supply within the U.S.” *Id.*

Danske Commodities further asserts that its proposed exports will not impair or tend to impede the sufficiency of electric supplies in the U.S. or the regional coordination of electric utility planning or operations. App. at 5. The Applicant states that it “will make all necessary commercial arrangements and will obtain any and all other regulatory approvals required in order to schedule and deliver power exports.” *Id.* at 4.

The existing international transmission facilities to be utilized by the Applicant have been previously authorized by Presidential permits issued pursuant to Executive Order 10485, as amended, and are appropriate for open access transmission by third parties. See App. at Exhibit C.

Procedural Matters: Any person desiring to be heard in this proceeding should file a comment or protest to the Application at Electricity.Exports@hq.doe.gov. Protests should be filed in accordance with Rule 211 of Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (FERC’s) Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 CFR 385.211). Any person desiring to become a party to this proceeding should file a motion to intervene at Electricity.Exports@hq.doe.gov in accordance with FERC Rule 214 (18 CFR 385.214).

A final decision will be made on the requested authorization after the environmental impacts have been evaluated pursuant to DOE’s National Environmental Policy Act Implementing Procedures (10 CFR part 1021) and after DOE evaluates whether the proposed action will have an adverse impact on the sufficiency of supply or reliability of the United States electric power supply system.
