This notice amends the

Amendment

This notice amends the determination of cultural affiliation of three notices of inventory completion published in the **Federal Register** on January 16, 2025 (90 FR 4793); March 17, 2025 (90 FR 12350); and June 3, 2025 (90 FR 23559). Repatriation of the human remains and associated funerary objects in the original notices of inventory completion has not occurred.

Determinations

The FLMNH has determined that:

- There is a connection between the human remains and associated funerary objects described in the original notice and the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians; Seminole Tribe of Florida; and The Muscogee (Creek) Nation.
