Pine Prairie Energy Center, LLC; Notice of Schedule for the Preparation of an Environmental Assessment for the Pine Prairie Energy Center Phase IV Expansion Project

On August 8, 2025, Pine Prairie Energy Center, LLC (Pine Prairie) filed an application in Docket No. CP25–533–000 requesting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act to construct and operate certain natural gas pipeline facilities. The proposed project is known as the Pine Prairie Energy Center Phase IV Expansion Project

(Project) and would amend Pine Prairie's certificated total capacity to 87.2 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas (61.1 Bcf of working gas and 26.1 Bcf of base gas) and reduce the maximum daily delivery capability from 3.2 Bcf/day to 3.0 Bcf/day.

On August 22, 2025, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission or FERC) issued its Notice of Application for the Project. Among other things, that notice alerted agencies issuing federal authorizations of the requirement to complete all necessary reviews and to reach a final decision on a request for a federal authorization within 90 days of the date of issuance of the Commission staff's environmental document for the Project.

This notice identifies Commission staff's intention to prepare an environmental assessment (EA) for the Project and the planned schedule for the completion of the environmental review.¹ The EA will be issued for a 30-day comment period.

Schedule for Environmental Review

Issuance of EA January 23, 2026

90-day Federal Authorization Decision

Deadline² April 23, 2026

If a schedule change becomes necessary, additional notice will be provided so that the relevant agencies are kept informed of the Project's progress.

Project Description

The Project is in Evangeline Parish, Louisiana, and would consist of the following facilities:

- a new natural gas storage cavern (Cavern No. 6);
- 0.16 mile of natural gas, fresh water, and brine return pipelines that would interconnect with existing systems;
- new brine filtration, gas heating, and dehydration equipment, and demolition of existing out-of-service brine filtration equipment;
- a new 19,000 horsepower electric motor-driven compressor unit in an extension of the existing compressor building;
- about 2.4 miles of 30-inch-diameter header loop pipeline; and

- modification of the existing ANR-North Meter Station and Highway 10 Valve Site.

Background

On September 17, 2025, the Commission issued a *Notice of Scoping Period Requesting Comments on Environmental Issues for the Proposed Pine Prairie Energy Center Phase IV Expansion Project* (Notice of Scoping). The Notice of Scoping was sent to affected landowners; federal, state, and local government agencies; elected officials; environmental and public interest groups; Native American tribes; other interested parties; and local libraries. In response to the Notice of Scoping, the Commission received comments from Ironworkers Local 623 of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, expressing support for the project, and Our Children's Trust, a legal advocacy group that commented agency actions must be consistent with protecting the rights to life, personal security, other liberties of young people, and children's equal protection of the law. All substantive comments will be addressed in the EA.

I. General Information

A. Does this action apply to me?

This action is directed to the public in general. This action may, however, be of interest to all who manufacture, process, or distribute industrial chemicals. Since other entities may also be interested, the Agency has not attempted to describe all the specific entities that may be affected by this action.

II. What action is the Agency taking?

Under EPA contract number 68HERD24A0001, contractor and subcontractors General Dynamics Information Technology Inc. of 3150 Fairview Park Drive, Suite 100, Falls Church, VA 22042, COMPTech Computer Technologies Inc. of 8534 Yankee Street, Suite 1C, Dayton, OH 45458, and Gridiron IT Solutions Inc. of 11180 Sunrise Valley Dr., Suite 210, Reston, VA 20191, will assist the Office of Pollution Prevention and Toxics (OPPT) in the integration of previously owned Office of Research and Development (ORD) scientific applications, data, models, and systems within the CBI environments to enhance decision making capabilities. This is necessary to improve existing tools and integrate new tools that are only accessible through computer access to the TSCA CBI.

Contractors working on this project will be required to have full access to the entire IT system that houses TSCA CBI data and materials. This level of access is required for data movement and migration. (OCSPP), focusing on enhancing decision making capabilities in support of TSCA. The scope includes integrating the current CBI environment with enhanced ORD tools and models for process improvement and decision making. The initiative aims to streamline TSCA decision making through improvement in existing tools and integrating new capabilities.

In accordance with 40 CFR 2.306(j), EPA has determined that under EPA contract number 68HERD24A0001, GDIT, Comptech Computer Technologies, and Gridiron IT Solutions will require access to CBI submitted to EPA under all section(s) of TSCA to perform successfully the duties specified under the contract. GDIT, Comptech Computer technology, and Gridiron IT Solutions personnel will be given access to information submitted to EPA under all section(s) of TSCA. Some of the information may be claimed or determined to be CBI.

EPA is issuing this notice to inform all submitters of information under all sections of TSCA that EPA may provide GDIT, Comptech Computer Technologies, and Gridiron IT Solutions access to these CBI materials on a need-to-know basis only. All access to TSCA CBI under this contract will take place at EPA Headquarters and GDIT site located at 3150 Fairview Park Dr., Suite 100, Falls Church, VA 22042, in accordance with EPA's *TSCA CBI Protection Manual*.
