SUMMARY: The Civil Rights Cold Case Records Review Board received 822 pages of records from the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) related to two civil rights cold case incidents to which the Review

Board assigned the unique identifiers 2024-003-065 and 2024-004-011. NARA proposed 4 postponements in the records and later withdrew 2 of those postponements. On February 6 and 13, 2026, the Review Board approved 2 postponements, and determined that 821 pages in full and 1 page in part should be publicly disclosed in the Civil Rights Cold Case Records Collection. By issuing this notice, the Review Board complies with the Civil Rights Cold Case Records Collection Act of 2018 that requires the Review Board to publish in the **Federal Register** its determinations on the disclosure or postponement of records in the Collection no more than 14 days after the date of its decision.
