Pursuant to Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the “Act”)<sup>1</sup> and Rule 19b-4 thereunder,<sup>2</sup> notice is hereby given that on February 26, 2026, CME Securities Clearing Inc. (“CMESC”) filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC” or “Commission”) the proposed rule change described in Items I, II, and III below, which Items have been substantially prepared by CMESC. CMESC filed the proposed rule change pursuant to Section 19(b)(2) of the Act.<sup>3</sup> The Commission is publishing this notice to solicit comments on the proposed rule change from interested persons.

#### I. CMESC’s Statement of the Terms and Substance of the Proposed Rule Change

The proposed rule change of CME Securities Clearing Inc. (“CMESC”) is annexed hereto as Exhibit 5 and consists of modifications to the Amended and Restated By-Laws of CME Securities Clearing Inc. (“Amended and Restated By-Laws”), the Board of Directors Charter (“Board Charter”), the Risk Management Committee Charter, the Nominating Committee Charter, the Audit Committee Charter, and the Regulatory Oversight Committee Charter (the Risk Management Committee Charter, the Nominating Committee Charter, the Audit Committee Charter,
