This collection is considered a revision package because there is an estimated decline of 268 burden hours due to RWHAP recipients' increased familiarity with reporting requirements introduced in the currently approved collection.

A 60-day notice was published in the **Federal Register** on Month December 19, 2025, vol. 90, No. 242; pp. 59535–36. There were no public comments.

Need and Proposed Use of the Information: Accurate allocation records of recipients receiving RWHAP and EHE funding are necessary for HRSA to fulfill its monitoring and oversight responsibilities.

Likely Respondents: RWHAP Part A, Part B, Part C, Part D and EHE initiative recipients.

Burden Statement: Burden in this context means the time expended by persons to generate, maintain, retain, disclose, or provide the information requested. This includes the time needed to review instructions; to develop, acquire, install, and use technology and systems for the purpose of collecting, validating, and verifying information, processing and maintaining information, and disclosing and providing information; to train personnel and to be able to respond to a collection of information; to search data sources; to complete and review the collection of information; and to transmit or otherwise disclose the information.
