SUMMARY OF APPLICATION: Applicant requests an order to exempt certain limited partnerships, limited liability companies, business trusts or other entities (“Funds”) organized primarily for the benefit of eligible employees of The Goldman Sachs Group, Inc. and its affiliates from certain provisions of the Act. Each Fund will be an “employees’ securities company” within the meaning of section 2(a)(13) of the Act.

APPLICANT: The Goldman Sachs Group, Inc.

FILING DATES: The application was filed on June 7, 2021 and amended on December 1, 2021.
