WYOMING

According to information received from Mr. William L. Chapman, Commissioner of Agriculture of the Wyoming Department of Agriculture, European Corn Borer Quarantine Order No. 5, effective Sept. 1, 1952, has been revoked. The European Corn Borer (Pyrausta nubilalis Hubsn.) now exists in Brook, Goshen, and Platte Counties in the State of Wyoming and further restriction on the interstate movement of certain products and objects from the Infested Territory into that State is no longer necessary.

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
