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NOTE

Two indexes have been issued by this office in accordance with the sixty-second section of the act approved January 12, 1895, providing that "the Superintendent of Documents shall . . . prepare and print in one volume a consolidated index of Congressional documents." The present volume is the third of the series, and has been compiled upon the same general plan as were the two preceding indexes. Under the name of each committee of the Senate and the House of Representatives will be found the reports made by that committee. Under the name of each Congressman will be found documents and reports submitted to Congress by him. The documents and reports are entered again under their subject or subjects. A numerical list of Senate documents and reports and House documents and reports is added, as was done in the Index of the second session of the Fifty-fourth Congress. By means of this additional list, a document or report may be identified by number, as well as by author, title, or subject. The numbers of the volumes of the Congressional set in which the documents and reports will eventually be bound are given in this Index. No volume number is assigned to the House reports, because they will be bound in a single volume. In the schedule of volumes appended to the Index the serial numbers adopted by this office for the Congressional set have been added. This has not been done in the two preceding indexes.

This Index is not at all an index to the daily action of Congress. The Congressional Record contains such information, and in the Record there is a valuable index to proceedings. A history of all action taken upon bills and joint resolutions presented to Congress is found in the Senate and House Journals, and in the index to the Congressional Record, the arrangement being by the numbers of bills and resolutions. Bills and resolutions are not indexed in the present volume, but under entries for committee reports made upon them, the numbers of the corresponding bills or resolutions are added, except in the numerical list. This Index covers Congressional documents and reports, but does not include other publications of the Government. Such departmental publications are included in the Document Catalogues issued by this office, which contain also in more complete form the matter covered by the indexes.

A special session of the Senate was held, March 4-10, 1897. Only one executive document was transmitted to the Senate during that session. The document is included in this index. No committee reports were made during that period.
