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PREFACE

The documents included in the Numerical Lists and Schedule of Volumes for the 2d session of the Eighty-fifth Congress herewith presented number 3,048 divided as follows: 1,335 Senate reports; 1,442 House reports; 63 Senate documents; 208 House documents.

Beginning with the Eighty-fourth Congress, Senate and House reports on public and private bills are bound separately in volumes entitled Miscellaneous Reports on Public Bills or Miscellaneous Reports on Private Bills.

The bound set of congressional reports and documents listed in the Schedule of Volumes, beginning on p. 73, represents a set which is distributed only to the Senate and House libraries, the Library of Congress, the National Archives, and the Office of the Superintendent of Documents. The complete bound set as given in this schedule is not sent to depository libraries and international exchanges in this form but all the publications contained in these volumes are made available to them provided the series governing their distribution were selected in advance of printing as provided by continuing legislation which was first authorized by Public Act 171, Sixty-seventh Congress, approved March 29, 1922. The annual and serial publications of the departments, bureaus, and independent establishments of the Government and certain other publications prepared by Government agencies are sent without the congressional document numbers on the title pages and in the binding used by the offices issuing them; the other publications are sent bound in volumes corresponding to those listed in the schedule.

For the benefit of those libraries desiring to keep the serial arrangement, the serial numbers will be printed upon strips which will be furnished, on request, to designated depositories and international exchanges for attachment to the bound books.

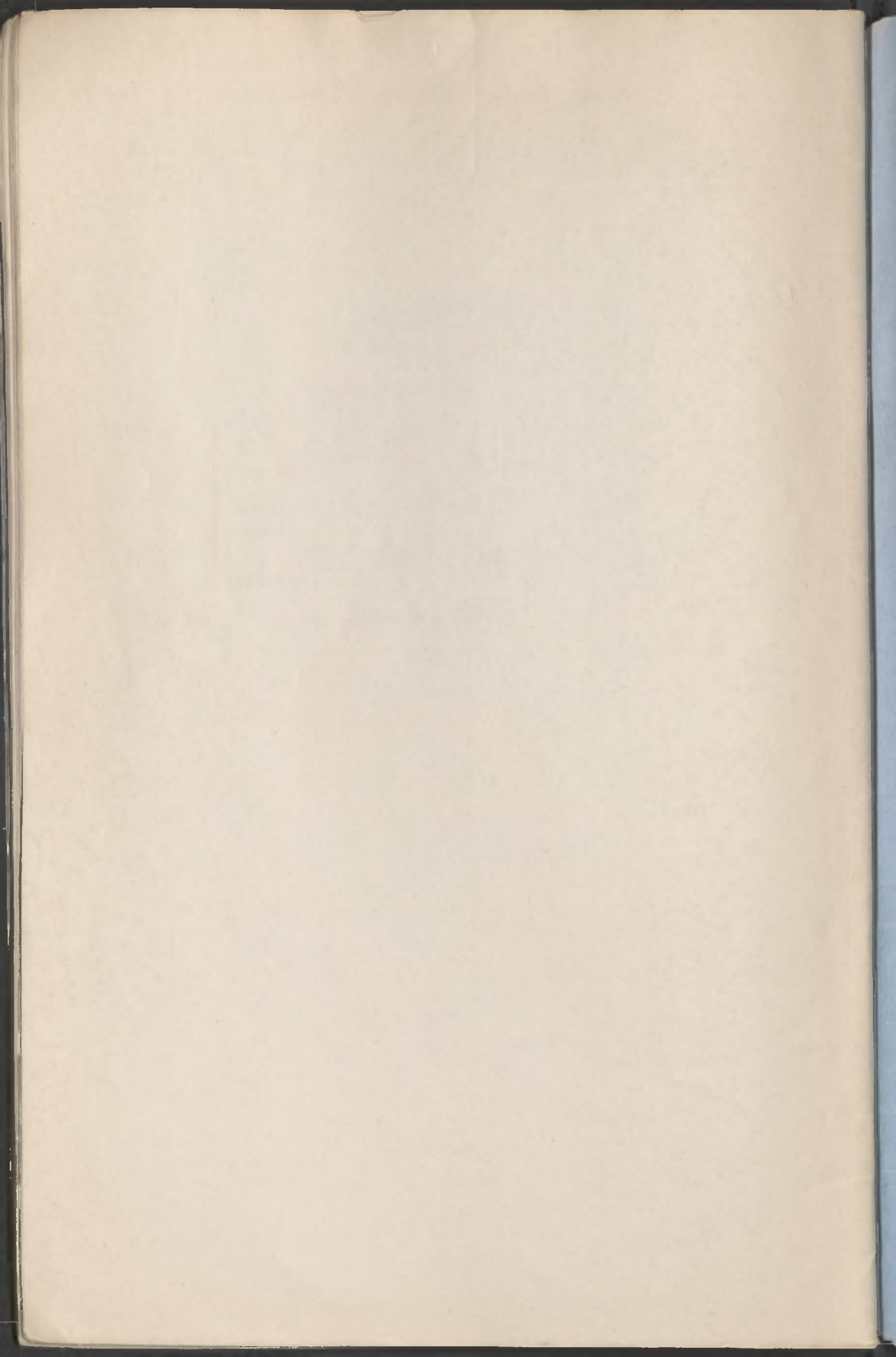
