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PREFACE

The "consolidated index of Congressional documents" for the third session of the Sixty-sixth Congress, herewith presented, is the thirtieth in the series prepared in the Office of the Superintendent of Documents in compliance with the requirements of the printing law of January 12, 1895.

The reports and documents included in this index number 829, divided as follows: Senate reports 166 (nos. 664-829); House reports 312 (nos. 1109-1420); Senate documents 125 (nos. 305-429, of which nos. 308, 312, 315, 317-319, 418, and 426 are blank); House documents 226 (nos. 825-1050). No subject entries could be made for House documents 844-846 and 884, which are Geological Survey water-supply papers 487-489 and professional paper 124, respectively, as the titles originally assigned to these serial publications have been canceled by the Geological Survey and other titles have not as yet been assigned to them.

Serial number 7772 is assigned to the Senate Journal and number 7773 to the House Journal.

House document 1878, 64th Congress, 2d session, 35th report of Ethnology Bureau, 1914, has been published in 2 parts. There will therefore be 2 parts of volume 105 of the House documents of that session, with serial numbers 7231, vol. 1, and 7231, vol. 2, respectively.
