Explanation

Words and figures inclosed in brackets [] are given for information, but do not appear on the title-pages of the publications catalogued. When size is not given, octavo is to be understood. Size of maps is measured from outer edge of border, excluding margin. The dates, including day, month, and year, given with Senate and House documents and reports, are the dates on which they were ordered to be printed. Usually the printing promptly follows the ordering, but various causes sometimes make delays. When Congress and session are not given with the numbers of Senate and House documents and reports, 61st Congress, 1st session, is to be understood.

NOTES OF GENERAL INTEREST

The Attorney-General of the United States has recently appeared before the Court of Appeals of the State of Georgia in a private litigation arising under the Federal Employers' Liability Act of April 22, 1908, and in support of the constitutionality of that act filed an elaborate brief (90 pages), which is one of the June publications of the Government. In a "preliminary statement" Gen. Wickersham says: "In thus participating in private litigation the Attorney-General feels that it is proper to say at the outset that the Government has no interest in any other question involved in this case except the constitutionality of the act referred to, and has asked the court to be heard, not for the purpose of assisting the plaintiff to recover, but solely because the validity of a wholesome and important act of Congress, passed for the protection of a vast number of citizens and for the safety of interstate commerce, is directly challenged." The unusual appearance of the head of the Department of Justice in a State court, and his fullness of citation in maintaining the constitutionality of a new law in which so many citizens are vitally interested, give importance to the Government brief in the case, which is entitled *Central of Georgia Railway Company, plaintiff in error, v. Victoria Waldo, administratrix, defendant in error*.

Bulletin 81, Bureau of Labor, dated Mar. 1909, but issued in June, has for its leading article Wholesale prices, 1890 to 1908. Everybody knows there has been a tremendous advance in prices, but this article, with its statistical tables, enables the reader to determine in figures what the advance has been and on which items in the list of principal staple commodities.

One of the Government's most useful annual manuals, the Statistical abstract, has just been issued for 1908, a little later than usual, but none the less welcome. The major part of its statistics cover the century and more from the beginning of the year 1800 to the end of the year 1908. The scope of the information given may be inferred from the titles under which it is grouped, namely: Area, natural resources, and population; Agriculture, forestry, and fisheries; Manufacturing and mining industries, and patents; Occupations, labor, and wages; Internal commerce and transportation; Mercantile marine and shipping; Foreign commerce; Internal commerce—commercial failures; Commerce of noncontiguous territory; Prices; Consumption estimates; Money, banking, and insurance; Wealth and public finance; Army, Navy, and pensions; Statistical record of the progress of the United States; Monetary, commercial, and financial statistics of the principal countries of the world.

Sixtieth Cong. 2d sess., S. doc. 735, is the final report of the Jamestown Tercentennial Commission. This Commission, composed of the secretaries of the Treasury, War, and the Navy, had general supervision of the Jamestown Exposition. Their report is illustrated by numerous full-page photographs.

The latest number in the series of Library of Congress bibliographies is List of works relating to Supreme Court of United States.

Edward L. Thorndike is author of Bulletin 4, series of 1909, from the Bureau of Education, and his interesting subject is Teaching staff of secondary schools of United States, amount of education, length of experience, salaries. The pamphlet includes a list of authorities and an index in its 60 pages.

In a new pamphlet, Laws relating to the Department of the Interior passed at the second session of the 60th Congress, is included an act to codify, revise, and amend the penal laws of the United States. This is the only part of the revision of the statutes, in progress for about ten years past, that has yet been reenacted and published. It was first printed as Public act 350, 60th Cong. 2d sess., in an unbound pamphlet of 80 pages, and is still available in that form. It takes effect Jan. 1, 1910.

Plant Industry Bureau Bulletin 139, American medicinal barks, by Alice Henkel, is another in an exceedingly popular series, of which Bulletin 89, Wild medicinal plants of the United States; Bulletin 107, American root drugs; Bulletin 51, part 6, Golden seal; Bulletin 90, part 3, Peppermint; Circular 6, Cultivation and handling of golden seal; Farmers' bulletin 188, Weeds used in medicine, all by the same author, are the earlier numbers.

Entomology Bureau Bulletin 79, Fumigation investigations [with hydrocyanic-acid gas] in California, is published with the purpose of making the art of fumigation simple and easy of practice. The author, Mr. Woglum, declares that it is not complex or mysterious, and says that "the improved system outlined in these pages shows how simple the practice of fumigation may be made." Orchardists may possess outfits of their own, or by association with neighbors, and do the work with their own employees.

Circular 29, Office of the Secretary of Agriculture, is likely to put one so-called remedy out of business. It gives the results of an analysis of a widely advertised serum for use by cattle owners. The analysis shows that the alleged remedy contains no serum at all. It is found to be 98 per cent water, with a little carbolic acid and oil of cloves and a very small proportion of what appears to be some form of vegetable matter. The Secretary's circular gives name and location of the manufacturer in full.

Census Bureau Bulletin 100 is a collection of statistics concerning Cotton production, 1908.

Geological Survey Bulletin 373 presents a subject of both economical and esthetical interest, namely Smokeless consumption of coal in boiler plants.

Interstate Commerce Commission Reports is a series in much demand at present. Volume 15, in buckram or leather binding, is now being de-

livered. It contains, in addition to the usual contents, a table of commodities that have been mentioned in any of the 15 volumes. This series is made up of reports of the legal decisions made by the Commission in transportation cases. They should not be confused with the Annual reports of the Commission.

The National Association of Railway Commissioners held its 20th annual convention in Washington, Oct. 1908. The official report of its proceedings is now published.

Foreign relations, 1906, in 2 parts, is one of the publications of June, 1909. This date of publication further justifies the statement of Gen. John W. Foster, formerly Secretary of State, in his *Century of American diplomacy*, that the State Department "exercises a large discretion in withholding diplomatic dispatches from publication."

A handy little narrow pocketbook is the one entitled *Questions and answers relating to reclamation act and its operations*, issued by the Reclamation Service. In the form of question and answer it gives the sort of information about the Reclamation Service and its work that the inquiring mind of the average American citizen is likely to seek.

The annual report on the beet sugar industry for 1908 (*Agriculture Department Report 90*), shows a decrease of 37,744 tons in production as compared with 1907.

Bulletin 8, series of 1909, Bureau of Education, is a most interesting list of 100 titles for a teacher's professional library.

Forest Service Circular 165 combines and supersedes Circulars 21 and 22. Its title is *Practical assistance to owners of forest land and to tree planters*. It tells how and why the Forest Service offers assistance to owners of woodland.

Work of the Coast and Geodetic Survey, 2d edition, is a pamphlet in which the Survey describes and explains its important functions. Much of its work is highly technical, but the pamphlet is not at all so, and may be read with interest and profit by the average man.

The scope of the examinations of applicants for appointment in the civil service of the United States may be dimly guessed at by running over the list of examinations which were announced by the Civil Service Commission during the single month of June, 1909. Examinations for the purpose of securing lists of eligibles for the following places were announced—and there may have been others which escaped the notice of this commentator: Aid and deck officer, Coast and Geodetic Survey; Apprentice plate cleaner, transferrer, and engraver, Bureau of Engraving and Printing; Architectural draftsman, for the Philippines; Assistant classifier, Geological Survey; Chemical assistant in dairying, Animal Industry Bureau; Civil engineer, Surveyor, and Transitman, Engineer Department, U. S. A.; Clerk-translator, Post-Office Department; Computer, Supervising Architect's Office; Designer of bridges and buildings, Philippine Service; Editor, Education Bureau; Engineer in wood preservation, Forest Service; Guard, United States Penitentiary Service; Laboratory helper, Chemistry Bureau; Laundryman, Freedmen's Hospital; Physician, Panama Canal Service; Poultry laborer, Animal Industry Bureau; Pathologist, Freedmen's Hospital; Topographic drafts-

man, Coast and Geodetic Survey; Trained nurse (male), Panama Canal Service. The pay offered for these places ranges from \$420 a year for the laundryman to \$2,000 for the editor.

There is a new edition of a useful manual, much inquired for, namely, *Fruits recommended by the American Pomological Society for cultivation in the various sections of the United States and Canada*. It is revised to date by an expert committee of the Society.

The Rev. William N. Brewster, Hinghua, Fukien, China, has prepared a note on Chinese cultural methods for the leitchee (*Litchi chinensis*), and the Plant Industry Bureau has published it in a leaflet. The leitchee is a Chinese fruit, and from Mr. Brewster's description apparently a delectable one.

Information for boards of examiners concerning applications, examinations, and appointments is a new manual issued by the Civil Service Commission. The examiners require information as well as the examined.

Often matter that would interest nonprofessional as well as professional readers is concealed in technical publications of the Government. Some of it is coming to light in a set of leaflets under the general title *Reprint of hydrographic information from Pilot charts and Hydrographic bulletin published by the United States Hydrographic Office*. No. 1 was issued Mar. 24 last. Each one has a subtitle of its own and is a brief essay on some important phase of sea lore. No. 5, on Submarine sound signals, issued June 30, is perhaps of as much interest as any, though either one of the series would rank well in a popular magazine.

A fourth Pan-American Conference is appointed for May, 1910, at Buenos Aires, the capital city of Argentina. A tentative programme for it has been issued by the International Bureau of the American Republics.

The quarterly bulletin of Railroad accidents in the United States for the first three months of the present year shows that 663 were killed and 15,122 were injured during Jan., Feb., and Mar., 1909. Dreadful as this record is, it does not include fatal and other accidents to persons not passengers or employees. That deadly class known as crossing accidents is thus excluded from the count. The record is strictly limited to passengers in transit and to employees on duty, and even accidents to employees on duty are not reported unless the victims are kept away from work for more than three days. If the unreported casualties should be added to the 15,785 reported, would not the aggregate be startling? And why should they not be added?

Part 1, New England, of the report on Taxation of corporations, by the commissioner of corporations, shows the systems of taxing manufacturing, mercantile, transportation, and transmission corporations in Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.

Animal Industry Bureau Bulletin 112, The loco-weed disease of the plains, is a 130-page discussion of a subject of momentous importance to western stockmen. The author, Dr. Marsh, has demonstrated that the

suspected weeds do really cause the disease and has suggested methods of curative treatment.

The learned report of the Solicitor-General to the President upon certain questions submitted to him concerning the meaning of the term "whisky" is now printed, and should interest both sides of the great national "wet" and "dry" controversy.

All of the publications referred to in these notes are June issues of the Government Printing Office.

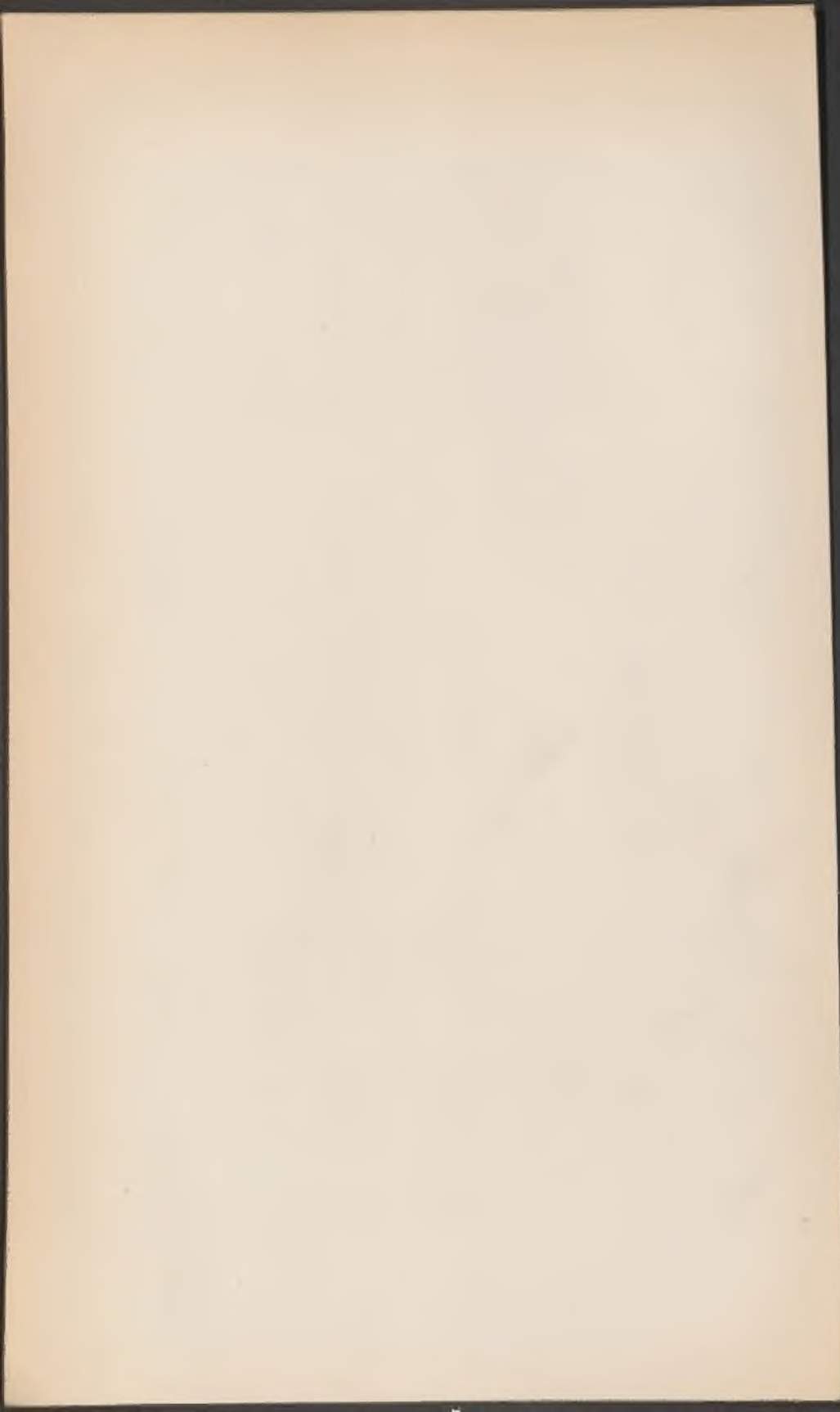

NOTE.—The Geological Survey is making a topographic map of the United States. The sheets of which it is composed are projected without reference to political divisions, and are designated by some prominent town or natural feature found on them. Three scales are used, 1:62,500, 1:125,000, and 1:250,000. These correspond, approximately, to 1 mile, 2 miles, and 4 miles to 1 linear inch on the map. The size, unless otherwise given, is about 17.5 inches in height by 11.5 to 16 inches in width, exclusive of the margin, the width varying with the latitude. A description of the topographic map is printed on the reverse of each sheet.

About one-third of the area of the country excluding outlying possessions, has been mapped, nearly every State being represented. Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, New Jersey, and the District of Columbia are completely mapped.
