Mount Hood Railroad Company (cessation of employer status)
Mount Hood Railway Company (employer status)

The Mount Hood Railroad Company has been an employer within the meaning of the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act. Its name appears in the Employer Status List under Item No. 4377, with the period of creditable service shown as October 23, 1905 to date.

In a letter dated October 25, 1968, Mr. C. D. Mayer, General Auditor, Union Pacific Railroad Company, stated that the Mount Hood Railroad Company ceased operations on October 15, 1968, and the Mount Hood Railway Company, a newly organized corporation, began operations on October 16, 1968.

On the basis of the foregoing, I conclude that on October 16, 1968, the Mount Hood Railroad Company ceased to be an employer under the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act and on that date the Mount Hood Railway Company became such an employer.

Appropriate Forms G-341 giving effect to the foregoing are attached.
