The Castleman River Railroad Company

By Form G-215 you requested to be advised as to the termination of employer status of The Castleman River Railroad Company. This Company appears on the Employer Status List under item No. 1033, with the period of creditable service shown as January 2, 1930 to date.

According to the information furnished in a memorandum to you dated June 5, 1961, from the Board's Contact Representative at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, it appears that The Castleman River Railroad Company ceased operations on or about May 29, 1957, because of insufficient funds. The Railroad last reported compensation for May 1957.

Based on the foregoing, it is my opinion that The Castleman River Railroad Company ceased to be an employer under the Railroad Retirement and Railroad Unemployment Insurance Acts as of June 1, 1957.

Appropriate Form G-341 will be released giving effect to the foregoing conclusion.
