The Tuskegee Railroad Company

On the basis of information furnished by an officer of The Tuskegee Railroad Company that the company last had compensated employees on February 28, 1963, in Opinion L-63-205 this office held that as of March 1, 1963, the company ceased to be an employer within the meaning of the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act.

In a letter dated December 13, 1963, Mr. B. A. Culpepper, Auditor, The Tuskegee Railroad Company, advised that one employee was carried on the rolls of The Tuskegee Railroad Company for the month of March, 1963.

On the basis of this information, Form G-341 will be released extending the coverage of this company under the Acts to and including March 31, 1963.
