In L-59-455, dated October 15, 1959, this office, on the basis of the information at hand, held that by reason of being owned and controlled by one or more carriers by railroad subject to part I of the Interstate Commerce Act and engaged in the performance of substantial services in connection with the transportation of property by railroad, the above-mentioned company has been an employer within the meaning of the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act.

In a letter to me of December 18, 1959, Mr. J. E. Wightman, Jr., General Manager of the Trailer Train Company, states that the company had compensated employees commencing October 1, 1959.

Accordingly, Form G-341 will be released showing coverage under the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act to have become effective as of October 1, 1959.
