Cessation of employer status

The above-named association has been an employer under the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act. Its name appears in the Employer Status List under Item No. 2454.2, with the period of creditable service shown as May 1, 1947 to date.

Form BA-3a, Annual Report of Creditable Compensation, submitted for the Fort Worth and Denver Railway Employees' Hospital Association shows compensation through April 1971. The following notation appears on the form: "Final Report. Association dissolved Feb. 28, 1971. No employees subject to Railroad Retirement Act subsequent to April 30, 1971."

On the basis of the foregoing information, it is my opinion that as of May 1, 1971, the Fort Worth and Denver Railway Employees' Hospital Association ceased to be an employer within the meaning of the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act.

Appropriate Form G-341 giving effect to the foregoing conclusion is attached.
