By reason of being a carrier by railroad subject to part I of the Interstate Commerce Act, The Narragansett Pier Railroad Company has been an employer within the meaning of the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act. Its name appears in the Employer Status List under Item No. 4428 with the period of creditable service shown as April 12, 1875 to date.

In an order dated February 27, 1953 the Interstate Commerce Commission approved and authorized the purchase and operation by the Narragansett Pier Railroad Company, Inc. of the properties and franchises of The Narragansett Pier Railroad Company. In a letter of April 8, 1953, Mr. Duncan Langdon, President, Narragansett Pier Railroad Company, states that as of April 1, 1953 the Narragansett Pier Railroad Company, Inc. acquired and commenced operation of the properties of the old company.

On the basis of the foregoing it is concluded that as of April 1, 1953 the old company ceased to be an employer within the meaning of the Railroad Retirement Act and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act and that as of that date the new company became such an employer.

Appropriate Forms G-341 will be released giving effect to the foregoing.
