NOTE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE

Pursuant to Public Law 89—497, approved July 8, 1966
(80 Stat. 271; 1 U.S.C. 113)—

“ . . .the Treaties and Other International Acts Series issued under the authority of the Secretary of State shall be competent evidence . . . of the treaties, international agreements other than treaties, and proclamations by the President of such treaties and international agreements other than treaties, as the case may be, therein contained, in all the courts of law and equity and of maritime jurisdiction, and in all the tribunals and public offices of the United States, and of the several States, without any further proof or authentication thereof.”



The Department of State has the honor to refer the Embassy of Ukraine to the Agreement between the United States of America and Ukraine Concerning Assistance to Ukraine in the Elimination of Strategic Nuclear Arms, and the Prevention of Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction, signed in Kyiv October 25, 1993, as amended and extended (the "Umbrella Agreement"), which is set to expire on December 31, 2021, per the provisions of the Umbrella Agreement.

On behalf of the Government of the United States of America, the Department proposes to extend the Umbrella Agreement through December 31, 2028. If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of Ukraine, the Department proposes that this diplomatic note dated August 23, 2021, together with the note of the Embassy in reply to that effect, shall constitute an agreement between the United States of America and Ukraine to extend the Umbrella Agreement, which shall enter into force on the date of the Embassy's note.

The United States Department of State avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of Ukraine in the United States of America the assurances of its highest consideration.

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The Embassy of Ukraine in the United States of America presents its compliments to the United States Department of State and has the honor to acknowledge receipt of the Note of the Department of State dated August 23, 2021, which proposes to extend the Agreement between Ukraine and the United States of America Concerning Assistance to Ukraine in the Elimination of Strategic Nuclear Arms, and the Prevention of Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction, signed in Kyiv October 25, 1993, as amended and extended (the "Umbrella Agreement"), and reads as follows:

The Embassy of Ukraine in the United States of America confirms that the proposal contained in the Note of the United States Department of State is acceptable to the Government of Ukraine. Therefore, the Note of the United States Department of State and this reply shall constitute an Agreement between Ukraine and the United States of America to extend the Umbrella Agreement that shall enter into force on the date of this note.

The Embassy of Ukraine avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the United States Department of State the assurances of its highest consideration.
