

## **Appointments**

To schedule, change, cancel or confirm a clinic appointment, please contact the Appointment Center at 1-800-463-6295, extension 7333, Monday through Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. To schedule an acute appointment, please call the Telephone Care Line Monday through Friday (except holidays) from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at 1-800-865-2441. If you have a life-threatening emergency, immediately dial 911.

#### **Automatic Teller Machine (ATM)**

There is an ATM across from the Barber Shop in Building 17H that is available 24 hours a day.





From Points North and South: Take I-95 to exit 93 for Route 222 east toward Perryville. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Route 222 and proceed for about two miles to the end of the road. Turn right onto Broad Street and continue through the Town of Perryville until you come to the entrance of the medical center. Follow the signage on the grounds of the medical center to the appropriate building.

From the Eastern Shore: Take Route 50 west towards Baltimore. Turn right onto MD-213 and continue for approximately four miles. Merge onto US-301 north toward Wilmington, Delaware, and continue for approximately 23 miles. Turn left onto MD-313 north

and continue for approximately 2.5 miles through the Town of Galena. After passing through Galena, MD-313 will change to MD-213. Continue on MD-213 for approximately 20 miles and turn left onto US-40 west. Continue on US-40 for approximately 13 miles and turn left onto MD-222. Take Route 222 until it ends and turn right onto Broad Street. Take Broad Street through the Town of Perryville until you come to the entrance of the medical center. Follow the signage on the grounds of the medical center to the appropriate building.
