

MEMORIAL

OF

SUNDRY CITIZENS OF CLINTON, NEW JERSEY,

Against the removal of the Deposites, and in favor of the Bank of the United States.

JUNE 10, 1834.

Referred to the Committee on Finance, and ordered to be printed.

To the honorable the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America:

Your memorialists, citizens of Clinton and its vicinity, N. J., respectfully represent to your honorable bodies, that they are laboring under deep pecuniary distress; that their produce in the short space of a few months has depreciated at least from twenty-five to thirty per cent.; that confidence is gone. A few months ago men regarded as responsible, are now looked upon with suspicion. No one is willing to hold bank paper; they take it to the banks, draw out the specie, and hoard it up; and unless something is speedily done business must stop. Your memorialists believe that this state of things is purely deducible from the removal of the Government deposits from the Bank of the United States. It is the deliberate opinion of your memorialists that confidence will not be restored unless the deposits are restored, and assurance given that the Bank of the United States will be re-chartered. Your memorialists believe that Congress is fully competent to redress our grievances, and they sincerely hope that Congress will not adjourn until relief is given. And your memorialists, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
