PETITION

OF

INHABITANTS OF WARREN COUNTY,

Against the Bank of the United States.

MAY 12, 1834.

Read, and laid upon the table.

To the honorable the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled :

The petition of the undersigned, citizens of the county of Warren, in the State of New York,

RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH :

That your petitioners believing that the act of Congress, incorporating the United States Bank, is unconstitutional ; that the operations of the Bank are highly prejudicial to the best interests of the nation ; that its immense money powers jeopardizè not only the purity, but the permanency of our republican institutions ; that it tends to create a moneyed aristocracy, inconsistent with the very existence of our free Government ; and that while it has almost unlimited control over the money operations of the people, it is yet wholly beyond the reach of their suffrages, and altogether irresponsible to them, do, therefore, firmly believe that the United States Bank ought not to be rechartered.

Your petitioners also believing that the United States Bank is not necessary as a fiscal agent of the Government ; that the local institutions, unchecked by the controlling interference of the United States Bank, are abundantly capable of transacting all the money operations of the Government ; and that they are the safe and constitutional depositories of the public treasures, do further firmly believe that the Government deposits ought not to be restored to the United States Bank.

Your petitioners, therefore, respectfully pray that the said Bank may not be rechartered, and that the Government deposits may not be restored to the said Bank.
