REPORT :

*The Committee on Foreign Affairs, to which was referred the memorial of Somerville Pinckney, administrator de bonis non, with the will annexed, of James Williams, of Annapolis, Maryland, have had the same under consideration, and report :*

That this memorial has been repeatedly referred to this committee. The reports made in 1828, 1829, and in 1836, which were all unfavorable to the claim, have been examined by this committee, and they find the facts correctly stated in those reports. Without recapitulating the statement of the grounds of claim, the committee, concurring in the former conclusions, recommend the adoption of the following resolution :

*Resolved,* That the prayer of the petitioner ought not to be granted.
