

## MEMORIAL

*Of a number of Citizens of Prince George's county, Maryland, praying the recharter of the Banks in the town of Alexandria, District of Columbia.*

JUNE 14, 1841.

Laid on the table, and ordered to be printed.

*To the Congress of the United States :*

Your memorialists, citizens of the county of Prince George, in the State of Maryland, would most respectfully represent, that the town of Alexandria, in the District of Columbia, affords the most convenient market for the sale of their produce, and the purchase of their groceries and other merchandise ; that tobacco is the staple article of produce raised by your petitioners, in the trade and export of which the town of Alexandria has been largely engaged, and, whilst it enjoyed the usual banking facilities possessed by the neighboring cities in Maryland and Virginia, offered to your petitioners a choice of markets, and produced that competition always so essential to the producer. Straited and crippled as the trade and business of said town has been since the 3d of July, 1840, by the disabilities under which their banking institutions have been placed by the legislation of Congress, your petitioners are convinced that they also have been injured and inconvenienced by the course referred to. As a matter of common justice, as well as of deep interest to your petitioners, they pray a recharter of the banks in the town of Alexandria, in such manner as may seem just and proper to your honorable body.
