Grants of land to the commissioned officers who served in the late war with Mexico.

SEPTEMBER 16, 1850.

A JOINT RESOLUTION concerning grants of land by the general government to commissioned officers who served in the late war with Mexico.

Be it resolved by the people of the State of California represented in Senate and Assembly as follows:

1. That our senators be and are hereby instructed, and our representatives requested, to use their exertions and influence to procure appropriate grants of lands by the general government to each and every commissioned officer, whether regular or volunteer, of the army of the United States, who faithfully and honorably served out a complete term of service in the late war with Mexico.

2. That his Excellency the governor be requested to forward to each of our senators and representatives in Congress a certified copy of this joint resolution.

Passed by the Senate and Assembly on the 15th day of
February, 1850.

A JOINT RESOLUTION concerning grants of land by the general government to certain
States, which were made in the war with Mexico.

It is enacted by the Senate and Assembly of the State of California, in session
assembled, that the following be and they are hereby enacted into law:

Section 1. That our senators be and are hereby authorized, and our representatives
be and are hereby authorized, to use their exertions and influence to procure appropriate
grants of land by the general government to each and every one of the
States, who faithfully and honorably served out a complete term of service
in the war with Mexico.

Section 2. That the Executive of the general government be and is hereby authorized to cause
to be prepared and presented to Congress a certified copy of this
act.
