*Grants of land to the commissioned officers who served in the late war with Mexico.*

SEPTEMBER 16, 1850.

A JOINT RESOLUTION concerning grants of land by the general government to commissioned officers who served in the late war with Mexico.

*Be it resolved by the people of the State of California represented in Senate and Assembly as follows:*

1. That our senators be and are hereby instructed, and our representatives requested, to use their exertions and influence to procure appropriate grants of lands by the general government to each and every commissioned officer, whether regular or volunteer, of the army of the United States, who faithfully and honorably served out a complete term of service in the late war with Mexico.

2. That his Excellency the governor be requested to forward to each of our senators and representatives in Congress a certified copy of this joint resolution.

A JOINT RESOLUTION concerning grants of land to the several governments in relation to the territory ceded to the United States by the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo, and for other purposes

It is resolved by the Senate of the State of California, that the following be the title of a bill to be introduced in the next session of the Legislature

1. That our senators do and we hereby authorize and our representatives do and we hereby authorize and empower the several representatives of the State of California in Congress assembled, to and they are authorized to confer with the several representatives of the several States, who jointly and honorably served out a complete term of service in the late war with Mexico

2. That the Executive the Governor be authorized to forward to each of our senators and representatives in Congress a certified copy of this bill
