SIR: In compliance with a resolution adopted by the Committee on Indian Affairs of the House on the 10th of March last, and transmitted to me by you in a letter of that date, calling for information as to what amount of money has been paid to William H. Thomas, as agent of the government, as attorney, administrator, or otherwise, for and on account of the Cherokees of North Carolina, and the amount due them, respectively, and paid to said Thomas, I have the honor to communicate, herewith, a report from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs dated the 19th instant, which it is believed contains the information asked for.

SIR: In compliance with your endorsement on the letter of Hon. R. W. Johnson, chairman, transmitting a resolution of the Committee on Indian Affairs of the House of Representatives adopted March 10, 1852, in the following words: "*Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of the Treasury be requested to furnish, or cause to be furnished,
